

FOTOGRAFIE

TEMA: WINTER WONDERS

VEREISTES

Die foto moet koue weerspieël.

Kleur of monochroom (swart en wit) foto's sal aanvaar word.

Grootte: A5 foto.

Montering: A4 karton met kleur wat by foto pas.

Geen manipulasie toelaatbaar (bv. deur iets by te voeg of weg te neem of te skuif in die oorspronklike foto).

Meld die besonderhede van kamera/selfoon agterop die foto/montering.

RIGLYNE

- Beligting en fokus is belangrik.
- Komposisie: Hou kunsbeginsels in gedagte.
- Indien die beoordelaar oor manipulasie twyfel, kan die oorspronklike foto aangevra word.
- Foto kan met of sonder 'n menslike element aangebied word.
- Foto kan 'n landskap, stad of dorp in koue weer weerspieël.
- Foto's kan binnenshuis of buite geneem word.
- Wat is tipies van winter? Onthou, dis nie net ys en sneeu nie. Dink byvoorbeeld aan mense wat warm geklee is, hetsy in aksie of stil. Dink selfs aan koponderstebo mense wat duidelik haastig iewers heen loop om die koue te vermy.

AANBIEDING

In 'n deursigtige plastiekkoevert en as volg gemerk: FOTOGRAFIE, jou naam, tak en area.

PUNTETOEKENNING

Koue nie oorheersend in die foto nie: -5%

Niks in fokus nie: -5%

Grootte van foto of montering nie korrek nie: -5%

Duidelike manipulasie: -10%

Geraam agter glas of soortgelyke bedekking: -5%

PHOTOGRAPHY

THEME: WINTER WONDERS

REQUIREMENTS

The photo should reflect coldness.

Colour or monochrome (black and white) photos will be accepted.

Size: A5 photo.

Assembly: A4 cardboard with colour-matching photo.

No manipulation is allowed (e.g., by adding, or removing, or moving something in the original photo).

State the details of the camera/cell phone on the back of the photo/mount.

GUIDELINES

- Lighting and focus are important.
- Composition: Keep art principles in mind.
- If the judge suspects manipulation, the original photo can be requested.
- Photo can be presented with or without a human element.
- Photo can reflect a landscape, city or town in cold weather.
- Photos can be taken indoors or outdoors.
- What is typical of winter? Remember, it's not just ice and snow. Think, for example, of people dressed warmly, either in action or still. Think of people with their heads stooped who are clearly walking somewhere hurriedly to avoid the cold.

PRESENTATION

In a transparent plastic envelope marked as follows: PHOTOGRAPHY, your name, branch and area.

MARK ALLOCATION

Cold not dominant in the photo: -5%

Nothing in focus: -5%

Size of photo or mount not correct: -5%

Clear manipulation: -10%

Framed behind glass or similar covering: -5%
