VEREISTES

Hierdie kompetisie word met 'n gewone huishoudelike naaimasjien, nie 'n borduurmasjien nie, gedoen.

Hierdie borduurwerk is nie rourandappliek nie; slegs 'n klein hoeveelheid (10%) is toelaatbaar.

Vryhandborduurwerk (*free motion*) en/of drukvoetborduurwerk, ook bekend as garingskets of garingverf, word op die wasgoedpennethjiesak gedoen.

Vryhandborduurwerk kan gekombineer word met sierstiksels van jou masjien; slegs 10% is toelaatbaar.

Die artikel word as 'n geheel beoordeel. Maak dus seker dat alle konstruksiemetodes korrek uitgevoer is.

Artikel moet met sy hanger vertoon word.

WENKE

- Borduurwerk moet die artikel komplimenteer en afrond.
- Goeie balans, vehouding en beplanning ten opsigte van ontwerp en sakkie sal 'n goeie eindproduk verseker.
- Waak teen die gebruik van baie bont tekstielstowwe, aangesien dit sal meebring dat die borduursteke verlore gaan.
- Stewige, wasbare tekstielstof wat hantering kan weerstaan, sal geskik wees vir hierdie artikel.
- Gebruik masjienvorduurnaalde in nr. 70 - 90.
- Borduurmasjiengaring soos *Rayon* maak die stikproses makliker.
- Deur die gebruik van verskillende dikte, kleur en tipe garing kan 'n goeie effek verkry word.
- Maak gebruik van goeie stabilisering.
- Gebruik 'n plastiekpypie om die hak van die hanger mee oor te trek.

MACHINE EMBROIDERY

CLOTHESPIN BAG

REQUIREMENTS

This competition is done with an ordinary household sewing machine, not an embroidery machine.

This embroidery is not raw edge appliquéd; only a small amount (10%) is allowed.

Freehand embroidery and/or presser foot embroidery, also known as thread sketch or thread painting, is done on the clothespin bag.

Freehand embroidery can be combined with appliquéd (decorative stitching) of your machine; only 10% is allowed.

The item is judged as a whole. Therefore, ensure all assembly (creation) methods have been carried out correctly.

Item should be displayed with its hanger.

TIPS

- Embroidery should complement and round off the article.
- Good balance, attitude and planning in terms of design and bag will ensure a good end product.
- Guard against the use of multi-coloured textile fabrics, as this will result in the disappearance of embroidery stitches.
- Sturdy, washable textile fabric that can withstand handling would be suitable for this item.
- Use machine embroidery needles in no. 70 - 90.
- Embroidery machine thread such as *Rayon* makes the stitching process easier.
- A good effect can be achieved through the use of different thicknesses, colours and types of thread.
- Take advantage of good stabilisation.
- Use a plastic pipe to cover the hook of the hanger.

PRESENTATION

In a clear plastic bag and marked as follows: **MACHINE EMBROIDERY, your name, branch and area.**

MARK ALLOCATION

Appearance: 60% Quality of work: 40%

Embroidery machine use: Disqualify

Raw edge appliques more than 10%: -5%

Embroidery (decorative stitching) more than 10%: -5%

Bag without hanger: -5%

Too few techniques: Lower mark

Tension and assembly (creation) techniques not good: Lower mark
